The VA Medical Center, Decatur, Georgia, requests termination of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Cobalt-60 Teletherapy License No. 10-011169-02. This request was made in December 1988, however a copy of the letter was never received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The Cobalt source was removed from this facility on December 15, 1988, by a Nuclear Regulatory Commission licensed source handler from the Siemens Corporation, and shipped to the AECL (Atomic Energy of Canada Limited) for disposal.

The Cobalt teletherapy unit was removed on December 19, 1988. A 6 MV Linear Accelerator was installed in the Cobalt room.
