SUBJECT: CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION FOR AMENDMENT REQUEST DATED AUGUST 29, 1989, AND SUPPLEMENT DATED SEPTEMBER 11, 1989

By letter dated August 29, 1989, and supplement dated September 11, 1989, SFC requested changes to License No. SUB-1010 to make administrative changes and to modify environmental detection limits and action levels. The administrative changes are organizational in nature and will not adversely effect the public health and safety or the environment. SFC also proposed to increase the detection limits and action levels for the fluoride, nitrate, radium-226, and thorium-230 parameters in water. These changes are consistent with Regulatory Guide 4.16. The increase in limits will not adversely effect SFC's environmental monitoring program; the ability to detect potential problems in time to take corrective action will still exist. Additionally, SFC is correcting some errors in Table 5-2. These changes will not adversely effect the public health and safety or the environment. Accordingly, pursuant to 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11), neither an Environmental Assessment nor an Environmental Impact Statement is warranted for the proposed action.
