This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Dr. R. B. Holtzman of this office on September 13-19, 1989, of activities at Zion Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-39 and No. DPR-48, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. T. Joyce and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. Subsequently, telephone discussions were held with Mr. D. Hemmerle of your staff on September 20 and October 3, 1989, and Mr. D.
