NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Georgia Power Company
Vogtle Units 1 and 2

Docket Nos. 50-424 and 50-425
License Nos. NPF-68 and NFF-81

During the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted on August 19 - September 15, 1989, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1989), the violation is listed below.

Title 10 CFR 55.23 requires the facility, in part, to certify that a physician has conducted the medical examination as required by 10 CFR 55.21. When the certification requests a conditional license based on medical evidence, the medical evidence must be submitted on NRC Form 396. Title 10 CFR 55.21 requires that a physician determine that the applicant or licensee meets the minimum health requirements.

Contrary to the above, on September 1, 1989, the NRC identified that an improper certification occurred on May 23, 1989, in that the certification was not based on a correct copy of the physician's determination dated March 2, 1989. The submitted NRC Form 396 did not include a restriction based on the medical evidence requiring that corrective lenses be worn while performing licensed duties.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement I).
