Gentlemen:

This letter refers to the special inspection conducted by D.L. Jacoby and R.O. Gonzales of this office on September 20, 1989, of the activities authorized by NRC Source Material License SUA-1472 and to the discussion of the findings held by the inspectors with your representative at the conclusion of the inspection. The enclosed NRC Inspection Report 40-8904/89-03 documents this inspection.

The inspection was an examination of the reclamation construction activities that have been completed and the conformance with License Condition No. 33 of Source Material License SUA-1472. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found not to be conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter in writing in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation (Appendix A) enclosed with this letter.

Additionally, the inspection identified areas that are considered unresolved items that will require additional information before we can conclude that all construction requirements have been met. As discussed between T. Osborn of Intera and E. F. Hawkins, R. J. Gonzales, and D. L. Jacoby of my staff on October 3, 1989, a response to the unresolved items will be expected within 30 days of the date of this letter. The response can be in the form of a meeting or a report.

The responses directed by this letter and accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.


