Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA, 5 U.S.C. 552), we request copies of the following documents:

Copies of any and all minutes and/or notes or correspondence of any type related to an August 21, 1989 meeting between NRC representatives James Taylor, Stewart Ebneter, and Thomas E. Murley and the Board of Directors of the FPL Group at the headquarters of the Florida Power and Light Company in Miami, Florida.

The Nuclear Energy Accountability Project requests that fees be waived, because "finding the information can be considered as primarily benefitting the general public," 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(a). For any documents or portions that you deny due to a specific FOIA exemption, please provide an index itemizing and describing the documents or portions of documents withheld. The index should provide a detailed justification of your grounds for claiming each exemption, explaining why each exemption is relevant to the document or portion of the document withheld. This index is required under Vaughn v. Rosen (I), 484 F.2d 820 (D.C. Cir. 1973), cert. denied, 415 U.S. 977 (1974). I look forward to hearing from you within 10 days as the law stipulates.
