Dear Mr. Shanbaky:

In reply to your recent letter, I wish to answer as follows:

A. We have converted all our Hepatitis testing to EIA rather then RIA methods. We are staggering the orders for the larger kits (T/3 Uptake and T/4) instead of receiving several in the same shipment.

In addition, we have obtained the forms (received 8-10-89) to apply for a license that would cover amounts of radioisotopes in excess of 200 uCi. We shall continue to monitor our total isotope on hand to determine if the upgraded license is necessary.

B. I must apologize for neglecting to inform the NRC of our change in location, but we simply did not reread the license since we received it in 1981 and had forgotten about the need to report changes.
