

Dear Dr. Mallett:

This is in response to your request for a comprehensive report as discussed in our telephone conversation of September 22, 1989 and your follow-up letter of September 28, 1989.

The information requested in items 1 through 5 of the outline enclosed with the letter can be provided to you in a comprehensive report. Putting it in the format of the outline necessitates the consolidation of three independent data bases which, for the most part, will require a manual effort. While doing that, we believe it would be prudent to verify the records in each data base by comparing them to the original documents from which they were obtained. That, too, will require a manual effort.

We expect the work to be completed by December 1, 1989 at which time a report will be available to you. If we encounter unforeseen difficulty in verifying the records and combining the data bases we will advise you accordingly.

The report will also respond to items 6 and 7 in your cutline.
