

I am forwarding for your file in the above captioned proceeding copies of documents received from the Office of the Secretary under covering memorandum dated October 18, 1989 from Samuel J. Chilk. The documents include:

- The September 8, 1989 Motion of Safety Light Corporation for an extension of time to file an answer and to request a hearing.
- A letter, dated September 11, 1989, from James Lieberman, Director, Office of Enforcement, granting a 20-day extension of time; and
- 3. A Motion by Safety Light Corporation, dated October 2, 1989, to defect the prehearing conference which includes a request for a hearing.

In view of the entension of time granted by the Director of the Office of Enforcement, the request for a hearing on the order modifying licenses, dated August 21, 1989, appears to be timely. Therefore, this matter should be considered together with the requests for hearing filed on behalf of the USR group of petitioners: USR Industries, Inc.; USR Lighting, Inc.; USR Chemical, Inc.; USR Metals, Inc.; and USR Macural Resources, Inc. Accordingly, we do not consider this latest filing by Safety Light Corporation to involve a separate docket. Please consider the Safety Light Corporation's answer and request for a hearing together with the USR group request Docket No. 30-5980 et al. - OM-2.
