
This is a request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act.

I should like, first of all, to refer to the enclosed handout regarding the intent of computer technicians to get their "babies" to "think and act like human beings". It is extremely obvious from this literature (and many like it) that computers--- YOUR computers (I refuse to even come near one) can "lie", may "trick", even "murder" humans--- you know what humans are, presumably you are one. 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Now computers have killed people already. At least, according to Science magazine. "So—" that journal reported, "We are to tell machines that their highest law shall be: 'Do not harm, do not kill human beings'".

BUT THAT IS NOT THE WHOLE STORY
