
SUBJECT: NONPOWER REACTOR SABOTAGE STUDY (R21W) STATUS REPORT FOR
MAY 1985

Site visits to the University of Missouri Research Reactor (MURR) and the Georgia Tech Research Reactor (GTRR) were completed. Information obtained from these visits is being analyzed and will be included in the report scheduled for release in June. The report includes an updated analysis of the National Bureau of Standards (NBS) Reactor. Information from the site visits also was used to define the exact TRAC analysis to be run.

Approximately \$25,800 was charged against the project in May 1985. The cumulative charges to date total \$113,700. The breakdown of costs is as follows.
