OCTOBER 20, 1989

By letter dated October 20, 1989, SFC requested an amendment to License No. SUB-1010 to authorize the abandonment of three monitoring wells and a delayed replacement of three others. As part of a compliance plan with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, SFC plans to construct a reservoir to contain stormwater runoff. The three wells to be abandoned (after being plugged) are located in the area planned for the reservoir. The other three wells would be affected by construction of the reservoir. These three wells will be replaced in the same general location within 90 days of completion of the reservoir. The lack of monitoring data from these six wells will not adversely effect SFC's monitoring program. This action will not adversely impact the public health and safety or the environment. Accordingly, pursuant to 10 CFR 51.22c(11), neither an Environmental Assessment nor an Environmental Impact Statement is warranted for the proposed action.
