
The NCRP Nominating Committee will soon be considering the Council membership election to take place in April 1990. As a Collaborating Organization of the NCRP, your suggestions of suitable individuals to be considered for Council membership are solicited. The Board of Directors usually identifies certain specific areas of competence to be of particular interest in relation to the Council's current program. This year, the Board recommended that the Collaborating Organizations be apprised that: (1) the following areas merit attention: embryology and teratology, nonionizing electromagnetic radiation (ultraviolet), nuclear medicine, radiology, ultrasound; and (2) appropriate consideration must be given to minorities and women.

As you know, suggestions proffered by a Collaborating Organization in a given year will be utilized in connection with the next four elections. You will recall that for the 1988 election you proffered the name of Frank Congel and Robert Alexander and for the 1989 election you proffered the names of John Baum and Hal Peterson. These individuals will again be considered in connection with the 1990 election. You may, of course, wish to offer additional suggestions. To facilitate this, I am enclosing a form which might be employed in proffering suggestions. You will note that the form emphasizes the need for biographical information on the individuals suggested. Appropriate evaluation of the individuals suggested is essentially impossible unless we have biographical information.

I am sure you understand that we customarily receive and, indeed, we need and appreciate many more suggestions than we have available vacancies in any given year. Consequently, only a small number of those proposed can be nominated. Nevertheless it is vital for the success of our nominating procedures that these be drawn from as large a pool of qualified individuals as possible. Thus, your suggestions are always extremely valuable whether the individuals concerned are ultimately nominated or not.

To ensure Nominating Committee consideration of your suggestions, it will be necessary to receive them before November 3, 1989. For your information, I am also enclosing a list of the current members of the Council.
