With respect to Carolina Power and Light, Brunswick Steam Electric Plants, Units 1 and 2, and Florida Power and Light, Crystal River Unit 1, when the final safety analysis report is received, it will be appropriate to publish, in addition to the required publications on the checklist, a Federal Register notice of receipt of application for an operating license, allowing 25 days for antitrust Intervention. (New section 50.30(d) (SECY R-110), page 46) now requires that the FSAR be accompanied by a "Notice of Application for an Operating License".) This should be coordinated with OGC.
