ESTABLISHMENT OF ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD TO PRESIDE IN PROCEEDING

Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register (37 F.R. 28710) and Sections 2.105, 2.700, 2.702, 2.714, 2.714a, 2.717 and 2.721 of the Commission's Regulations, all as amended, an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is being established in the following proceeding to rule on petitions for leave to intervene and/or requests for hearing and to preside over the proceeding in the event that a hearing is ordered.

(Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1) Facility Operating License No. NPF-3

This action is in reference to an Order published by the Commission on May 22, 1979, in the Federal Register (44 F.R. 29767-68) directing that the Davis-Besse facility, then in a shutdown condition, should remain shut down until certain actions specified in the Order were satisfactorily completed, and to the subsequent Order of the Commission issued on July 5, 1979, directing the establishment of an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to preside in this proceeding.
