

Dear Mr. Taft:



The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and the Toledo Edison Company submitted an application to the Atomic Energy Commission for a permit to construct the Davis-Besse plant on August 1, 1969, and the AEC regulatory staff has completed its evaluation of the application. An independent review was made by the AEC Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards. Both the regulatory staff and the ACRS concluded that the plant could be built and operated without endangering the health and safety of the public. The AEC program for the licensing and regulation of nuclear power plants is described in the enclosed booklet, "Licensing of Power Reactors," and the related booklet, "Atomic Power Safety."

A public hearing before a three-man atomic safety and licensing board to consider whether a construction permit should be issued for the proposed Davis-Besse plant is now in progress at Port Clinton, Obio. The hearing was recessed on Friday, January 29, and is scheduled to reconvene within a week. Copies of the resolution by the Council of the City of Euclid and this reply are being sent to the board members, the parties to the proceeding, and to the AEC's Public Document Room in Washington, D. C.

I am enclosing, for the information of the City Council, a copy of the regulatory staff's safety evaluation of the proposed Davis-Besse plant and a copy of our Betailed Statement of the Environmental Considerations, which was prepared in connection with our responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969.
