Dear Mr. Ashley:

This is in reply to your letter dated January 22, 1971, which enclosed a portion of a letter dated January 17, 1971, concerning the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station.

With respect to your constituent's concern that private dwellings along Sand Beach, Long and Lotus Point Beach may be bought to expand the Davis-Besse plant, we understand that the Toledo Edison Company has no plan to obtain any additional land for the Davis-Besse plant now or in the future.

In response to a number of inquiries on the plant, we have prepared a summary which describes the proceedings concerned with the licensing of the Davis-Besse plant, and the controls that the AEC will have over the plant during its lifetime. I am enclosing a copy of the summary for your constituent.


Dear Dr. Seaborg:
