Confirming the telephone conversation between Mr. G. Vissing, NRC, and your Mr. D. Mardis of June 26, 1978, we request that you submit a schedule for the permanent solution to the additional cooling for electrical equipment areas vital to safety. The schedule should provide dates for:

1. Submitting the details of the proposed modifications;
2. Initiation of procurement of critical path items;
3. Delivery of critical path equipment;
4. Beginning of installation, and
5. Completion of installation.

We request that you respond to this within 10 days of receipt of this letter.
