1. A statement of the issues or contentions involved in the hearing and the parties' respective positions thereon.
2. Preliminary proposed license conditions deemed appropriate in accordance with the Appeal Board's opinion and findings.
3. Citations of relevant authority.
4. A list of witnesses who might be called by each party.
5. A brief summary of the testimony expected from each witness (no written direct testimony will be used at the hearing).

In addition, the parties are requested to have the following documents in the hands of the Board by the same date (April 7):

- (a) Annual reports of Consumers not previously in evidence, including the most recent drafts.
- (b) Form 1, FPC (now FERC).
- (c) Form 10 K (SEC).
- (d) Prospectuses of the last bond or stock issue of Consumers.


