ORDER GRANTING APPLICANT'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER MOTION
TO COMPEL PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

The Department of Justice, on August 16, 1972, filed a motion to compel the production of four categories of documents from the applicant, including those which may be dated prior to January 1, 1960.

The applicant, on August 24, 1972, filed a motion for an extension of time to answer said motion. There being good cause for applicant's motion, and since none of the other parties to this proceeding objects to the granting of said motion of the applicant, it is herewith granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the applicant has until the close of business of September 7, 1972, in which to serve its answer to the motion of the Department of

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Justice to compel the production of the four categories of documents, and that the Department of Justice has until the close of business of September 14, 1972, in which to file any response to the applicant's answer.

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
