This is in partial response to your letter dated June 3, 1980 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, documents pertaining to the transportation of spent nuclear fuel from Portsmouth, Virginia to the Savannah River Plant in Aiken, South Carolina.

The documents listed below are enclosed and are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) located at 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC.

1. March 18, 1980 letter to Hillman from Stoneburner, Transnuclear, Inc.

As a result of a previous FOIA request (FOIA-80-145), the documents listed in the appendix have already been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC PDR.
