Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2
Proposed Revisions to Environmental Technical Specifications

Pursuant to Section 5.6.3 of the Millstone Unit No. 1 (License No. DPR-21) and Millstone Unit No. 2 (License No. DPR-65) Environmental Technical Specifications (ETS), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby proposes to amend its operating licenses by incorporating the changes identified in Attachment 1 into each unit's ETS.

The proposed changes reflect recent organizational title changes and the Technical Specifications are proposed to be clarified accordingly.

A benefit/cost analysis is not applicable in this instance.

The Millstone Environmental Review Board has reviewed and approved these changes.

NNECO has reviewed the proposed license amendments pursuant to the requirements of 10CFR170 and has determined that the proposal constitutes a combination Class I and Class II amendment. The basis for this determination is delineated in Reference (1), whereby NNECO transmitted proposed changes to Section 6 of


