

This License Change Application is submitted in support of Licensee's request to modify FOL NPF-1 in response to an Atomic Safety & Licensing Appeal Board's decision (ALAB-515) regarding jurisdictional control for establishing water quality levels and monitoring requirements. In their decision, the Appeal Board cited the 1972 amendments to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act for leaving control of these matters entirely with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This application will delete those portions of the Environmental Technical Specifications that are covered by EPA controls.
