PLANT - RESPONSE TO GENERIC ISSUES - DEGRADED
GRID VOLTAGE: AND, ADEQUACY OF STATION ELECTRIC
DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM VOLTAGES

Consumers Power Company made interim responses to the NRC information requests on generic issues, "Degraded Grid Voltage", dated July 9, 1979; and, "Adequacy of Station Electric Distribution Systems Voltages", dated August 8, 1979. These responses (dated August 23, 1979 and February 19, 1980 respectively) committed Consumers Power Company to providing additional information pending the results of testing and analytical work. The required testing has been delayed due to the extended shutdown at Palisades which was to be the implementation site for the test (as discussed in the previously referenced submissions). Testing has been completed recently and evaluation of the data is in progress.

As discussed with Mr Walter Paulson of your staff on July 24, 1980, Consumers Power Company will submit responses to the open items of these generic issues by September 1, 1980.
