

Dear Mr. Devine:

Please find enclosed an application to permit the export of up to 10,000 kg of uranium, enriched to ≤ 2.85 wt.% ^{235}U , in the form of UF_6 . This material has been stored at the Exxon Nuclear Company facilities in Richland, Washington and was originally intended for use in the KRB reactor. With the closure of that reactor, Kernkraftwerk RWE-Bayernwerk has requested export of the material to the Federal Republic of Germany for further storage and ultimate use in the Gundremmingen nuclear power facilities.
