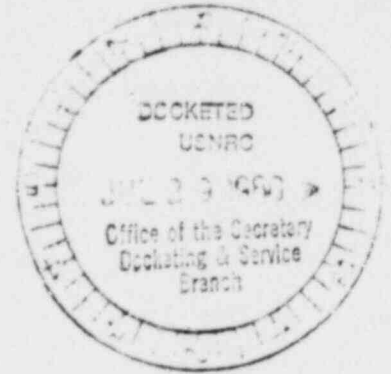

Dear Mr. Keppler:

This letter provides the Commonwealth Edison response to
Item 4 of IE Bulletin 80-17, which was transmitted by Reference
(a).

To comply with Items 4.a through 4.d, the following
procedures have been reviewed and revised:

DGP 2-3 - Unit 2/3 Reactor Scram

DGA 18 - Anticipated Transient with Incomplete Scram

DOP 1100-2 - Injection of Standby Liquid Control

All items discussed in Items 4.a through 4.d were addressed
as stated except Item 4.b.1. Item 4.b.1 has been addressed in
accordance with General Electric's letter to all BWR Operating
Station Superintendents, dated July 2, 1980. General Electric
recommended that for adjacent rods, a two (2) rod criteria be
applied as opposed to the five (5) rod criteria of IE Bulletin No.
80-17.


To comply with Item 4.e, the preliminary training


