This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. P. Jerman of this office on March 3, 1980, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 07-03860-02, 07-03860-04 and SUB-972 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. P. Jerman with Mr. G. Dixon of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.
