Dear Sir:

We are attorneys for Chem-Nuclear Systems, Inc., and submit this request for copies of records on behalf of our client pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. §552, and the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, 10 C.F.R. Part 9, Subpart A.

As used in this request, "NRC" means the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and all of its offices and divisions reporting to or through the Executive Director for Operations, "records" means all documents and things as defined in 10 C.F.C. §9.3a(b), and including, without limitation, all opinions, orders, policy statements, files, letters, reports, memoranda and studies made by, in the possession of, or under the control of the NRC within the period from January 1, 1977 through the present.

This request pertains to information generated from the Department of Energy and from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on Form 7-41 Rev. (10-78) D.P. and its earlier form.

Records and format requested:

1. All information is to be reported for quarters from Q I 1977 through the latest available quarter. An annual summary should be prepared for 1977, 1978 and 1979.

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The data set should be restricted to shipments of low level (radwaste) material originating (Q 9A) from nuclear electric generating facilities.

2. a. For each facility report weight (Q 22) and (Volume Q 23) shipped for burial to receiver (10 A). Calculate and Print % to each burial site.

2. b. 1) Allocate all shipments by Carrier (Q 18B) (by weight and by volume). The printout should show, or allow us to segregate the actual physical shipment and the proportions partitioned by: common carriers, contract carriers, generating facility owned and/or operated shipments, shipments where carrier and receiver are the same entity (i.e., shipped and buried by NECO, Chem-Nuclear) where shipper is not one of the above. Show shipments by package type.

2. b. 2) Indicate the proportion of shipments carried by "1", "2", "3", and more carriers.

2. b. 3) Aggregate data specified under 2 a and b for each state.

3. a. Within each class of carrier (common carrier, contract carrier, carrier owned and/or operated by generating facilities (TVA, PASNY, etc.), carrier owned and/or operated by burial site owner (NECO, Chem-Nuclear, etc.), carrier owned and/or operated by firm providing other nuclear waste services but not elsewhere classified, including brokers, ATCOR, Hittman Chemical, etc.) specify the carrier and the physical shipment as well as the percentage shipped by the firm.


3. b. For each carrier and then aggregated by class, the physical dimensions and the proportions moved by type of package, i.e., shielded package, unshielded package, cask, etc.
