This confirms the discussion between Messrs. R. A. Frazar and J. W. Briskin of your staff and Mr. H. S. Phillips of my staff on July 15, 1980, concerning actions you are taking with regard to the stop-work order (Order No. S21A) of April 11, 1980, and as documented in our letter dated April 17, 1980.

Specifically, we understand that you intend to:

- Verify that the radiographic process for determining AWS welder qualifications is adequately controlled.
- b. Proceed to requalify welders on a limited basis (approximately six).
- c. Requalify other welders, if the basis for welder qualification proves to be adequately controlled.

We have no further questions on the above steps at this time. If your understanding of this matter is not consistent with the above, please contact this office immediately.
