Subject: Combined Inspection 30-01300/80-01; 70-02749/80-01

This refers to your letter dated May 19, 1980, in response to our letter dated April 24, 1980.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions you documented in response to our correspondence. However, your letter has been reviewed and additional information is found to be needed.

In response to item A, you failed to indicate how you would ensure that all personnel working in your restricted area (nuclear medicine) would be properly instructed in all applicable revisions of NRC regulations and your license. You have indicated that identified surveys and dose calibrator checks are now being performed, and this is responsive to items B.2 and B.3. However, you n. d to assure that personnel are aware of all appropriate requirements and that all requirements are followed.

In response to ite B, you have indicated that weekly wipe tests of your sealed sources are being performed and the results recorded. This test is only required to be performed at six month intervals, but must have a sensitivity of 0.005 microcuries. You have failed to provide information that the test you are now performing has the required sensitivity.

Please respond to this office within seven (7) days of receipt of this letter a written statement containing the requested information.
