This office received an allegation that called into question your job performance at Nine Mile Point, Unit 2, due to possible involvement with controlled substances. Since our regulations do not explicitly cover this area, our policy is to turn allegations like this over to the licensee for investigation and disposition as we are obviously concerned about the fitness for duty of nuclear plant workers.

Consequently, we asked Niagara Mohawk to investigate this matter and inform us of their results. Because the Niagara Mohawk investigation was unable to establish any involvement by you in illegal use or distribution of controlled substances associated with your current employment at the Nine Mile Point Unit 2 facility, we consider this matter closed. Our file on this matter is enclosed for your information.

We are sorry for any inconvenience that this investigation has imposed on you, but we hope you understand our obligation to assure such matters are investigated and appropriately dispositioned to assure quality work at nuclear facilities and ultimately the health and safety of the public.
