

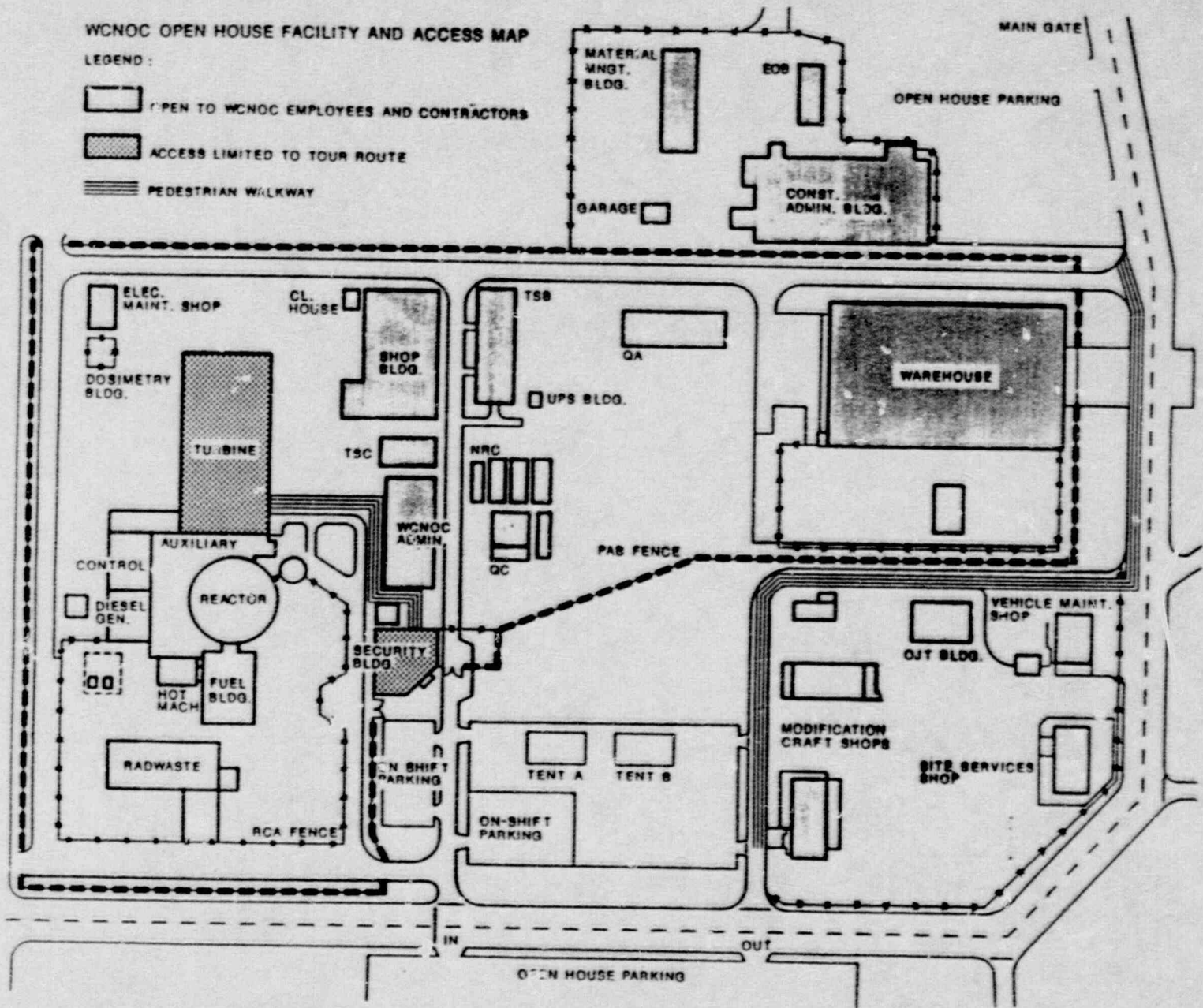

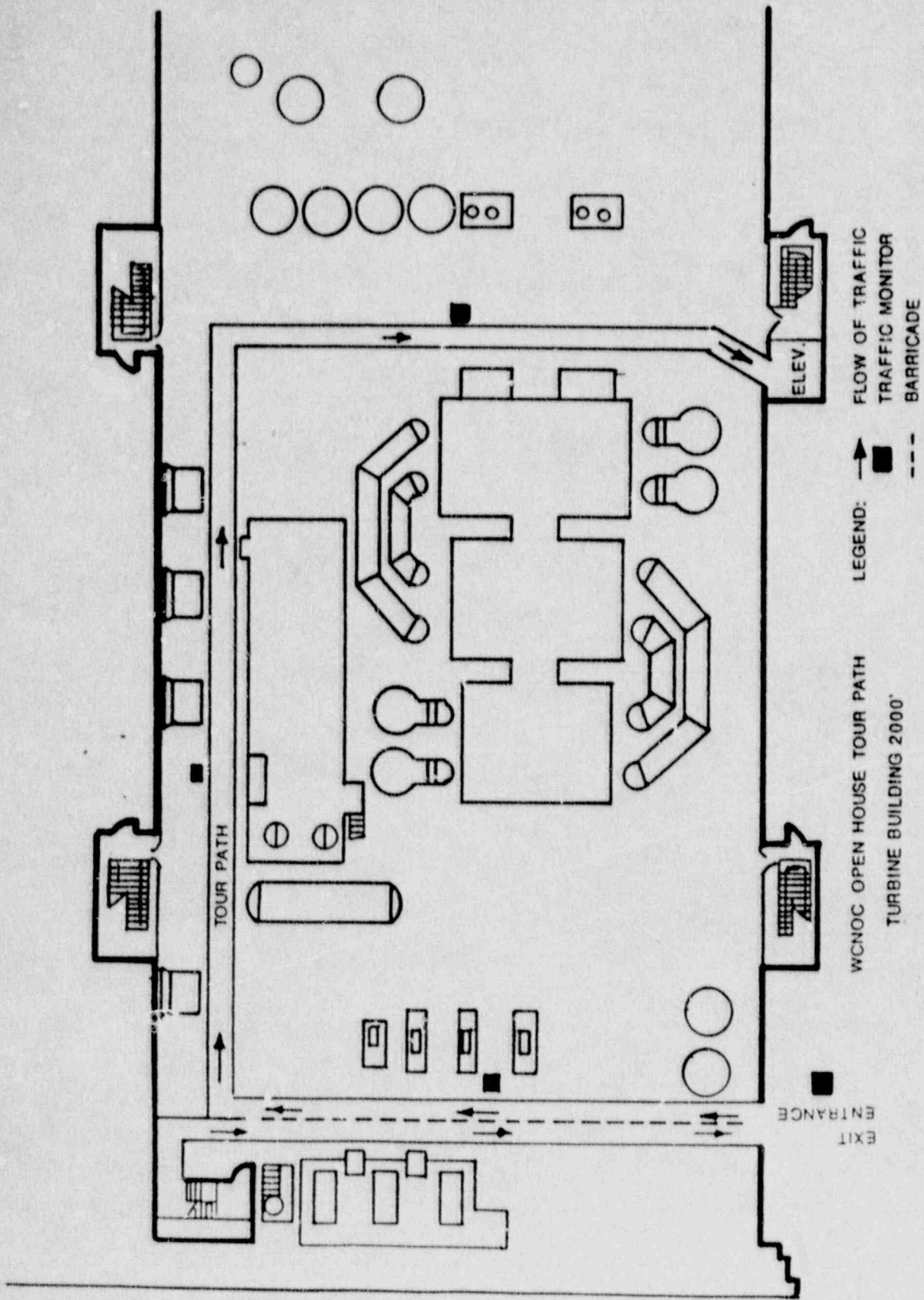

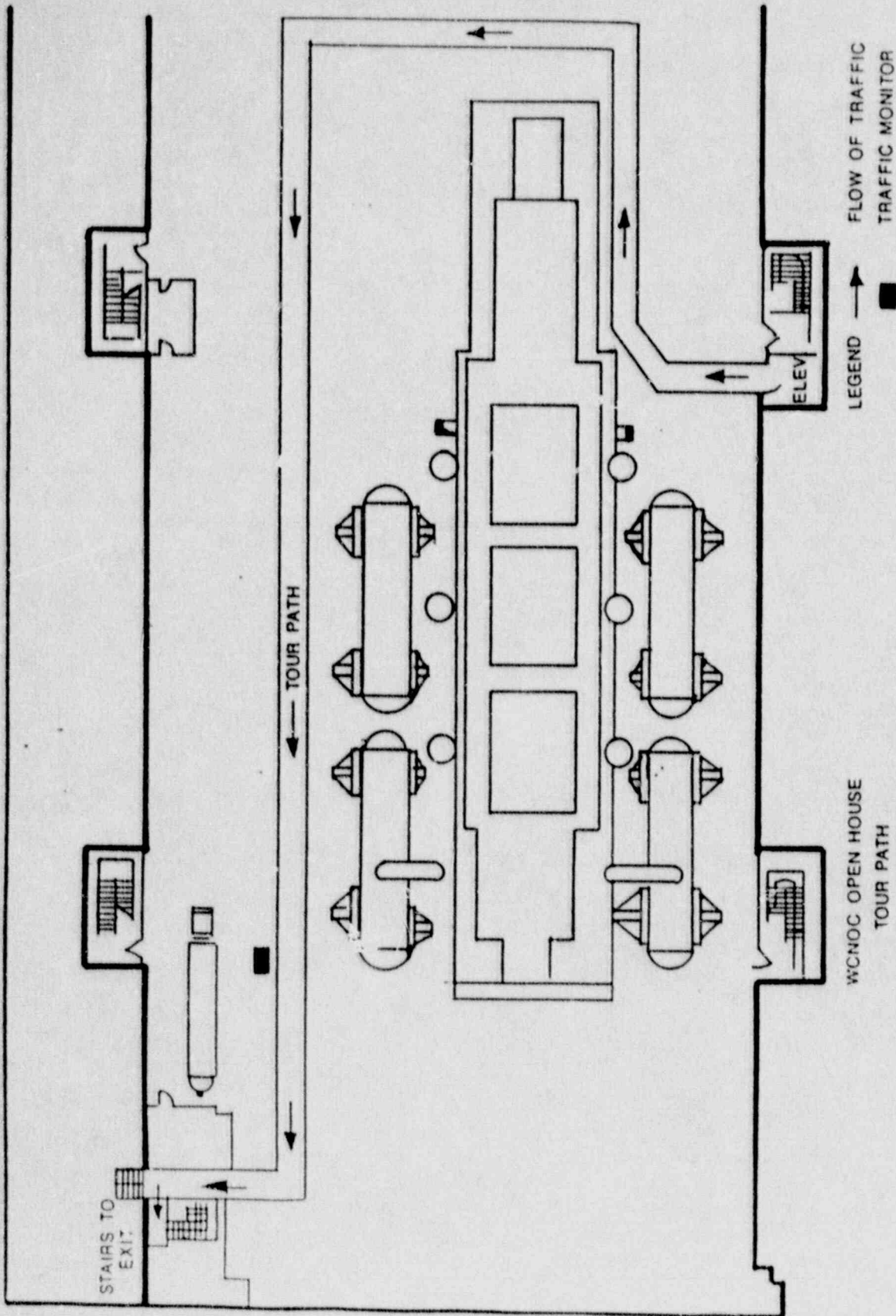
WCNOC OPEN HOUSE FACILITY AND ACCESS MAP

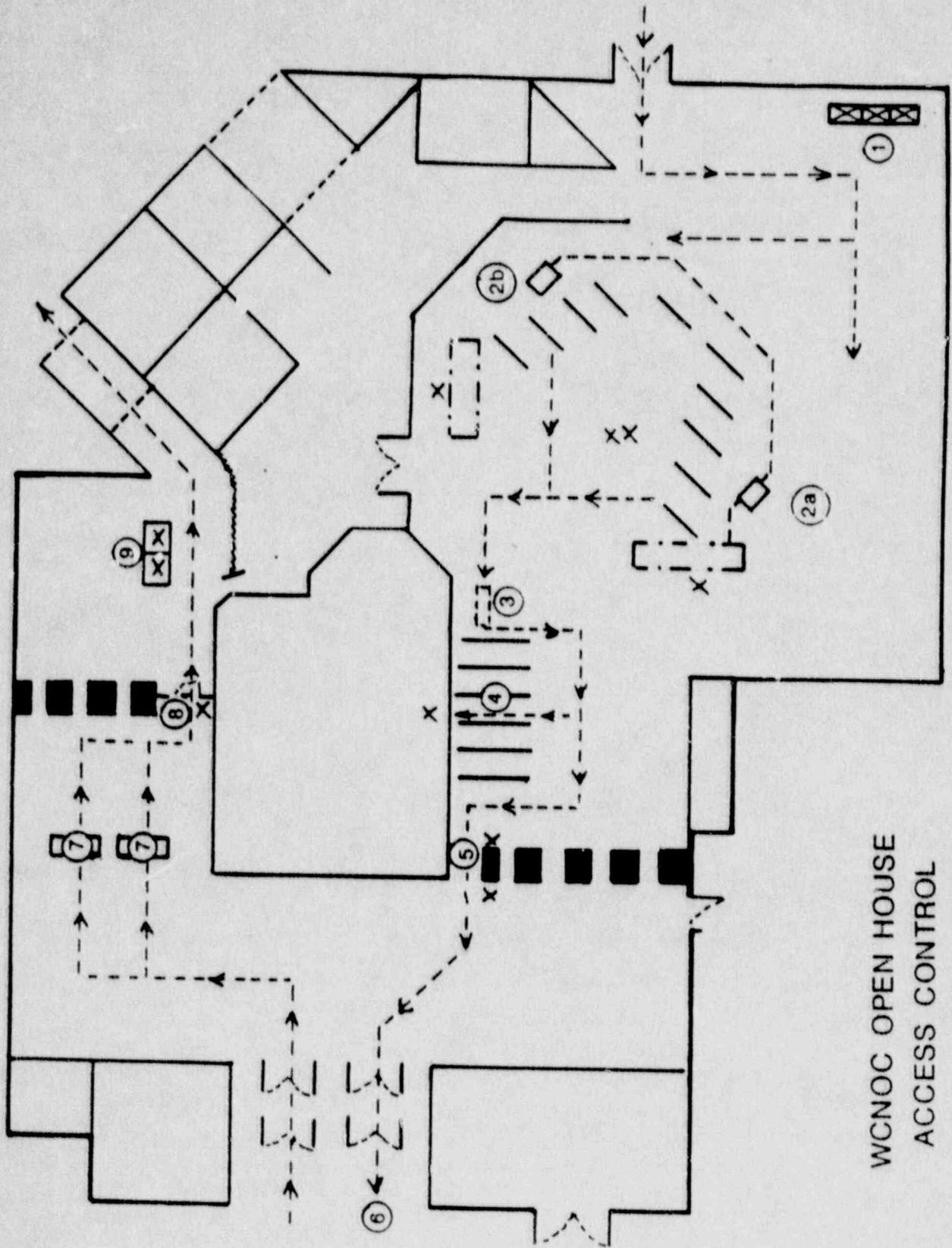
