NOTIFICATION OF MODE CHANGE

Dear Mr. Martin:

The District has made a mode change, as described in the Technical Specifications for Rancho Seco, from cold shutdown to refueling shutdown. This mode change was initiated by the detensioning of the reactor vessel head on October 14, 1989.

In preparation for this change, the District performed a thorough review of pertinent procedures, required training, open commitments, and other appropriate programs to verify that the necessary actions were complete prior to detensioning of the reactor vessel head. Upon certification by each of my managers that to the best of their knowledge the necessary actions were complete, the mode change was accomplished.
