Dear Neal:

This is to request written confirmation of the applicable NRC regulations pertaining to the export of IAEA Safeguards Samples to be shipped from GE Nuclear Energy, Wilmington, NC to IAEA, Vienna, Austria.

Further, you are to take into consideration that 100 grams of contained U-235 have already been shipped as IAEA Safeguards Samples from the Wilmington location in the year 1989 pursuant to Subpart B, Exemptions 110.11, Export of IAEA Safeguards Samples.

Therefore, it is our understanding that 10 CFR Subpart C, General Licensing 110.21(b)(1) would apply for the shipment of 325.0 grams UO₂, containing 279.7 grams Uranium, containing 9.32 grams U-235. $.0353 \times .001109 = .308 \text{ g/gm}^2$
