Please be advised we are in receipt of your letter noting the above violation of our Nuclear Medicine Department.


The noted violation is being corrected as follows:

1. Immediate corrective action has been taken to lock the door of the Nuclear Medicine Department any time a Nuclear Medicine Staff employee is not physically present.
2. A door with a lock has been ordered to be installed between the radiopharmaceutical preparation room and the unrestricted area. Completion of this project is scheduled for October, 1989.

These corrective measures will ensure that licensed by-product materials are secured against unauthorized removal and materials not in storage will be under constant surveillance and immediate control.
