For the Licensing Board's information, I am providing a copy of a "Notice to Parties in Interest" which I received from the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee. The Notice advises that, with respect to All Chemical Isotope Enrichment, Inc. (AllChemIE), a hearing would be held on October 19, 1989 to consider the following two matters:

1. Motion by John H. Smelser, Jr. and C.E.O., Inc. to convert case to Chapter 7; (liquidation), and
2. Motion by the U.S. Trustee to convert case to Chapter 7.

My information is that the two motions in questions were granted on October 19, 1989. I do not know if AllChemIE intends to appeal. I am attempting to locate, from several sources, a copy of the Order granting the motion.
