1 am responding to your letter of October 3, 1989, to Mr. Dennis Rathbun regarding our Solicitation Number RS-PER-90-321 for NRC's upcoming Senior Executive Service Training Conference.

We have re-evaluated our requirement and conclude that the facility location for the conference was too restrictive. As a result, we issued an amendment to the solicitation on October 10, 1989, deleting this restriction.

Please be assured that we will fairly consider all sources who respond to this solicitation and will evaluate each proposal against the evaluation criteria specified. (See Sections L.13 and M.3 of the enclosed solicitation document which address the required technical proposal content and evaluation criteria). Final selection will be based on that offeror whose technical/cost relationship is most advantageous to the Government, with technical merit being a more significant factor.

We appreciate your taking the time to address this issue and trust that our actions are satisfactory.
