The same allegations were made to the Clinton, Quality Assurance Manager who hired a private firm to investigate the allegations. At our request a copy of the investigation report was sent to this office. Based on a review of that report (Case No. 89A0807) and a review of the allegedly altered data sheet, we find the evidence does not support the allegations. We therefore, consider these allegations (PIII-89-A-0114) closed.
