SUBJECT: FITZPATRICK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT - GENERIC LETTER 83-28, ITEM 2.2 (PART 1), EQUIPMENT CLASSIFICATION PROGRAM FOR ALL SAFETY RELATED COMPONENTS (TAC NO. 53672)

Generic Letter 83-28, Item 2.2.1, required that the Power Authority of the State of New York (PASNY), licensee for the FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant, describe in considerable detail the program for classifying all safety-related components other than reactor trip system components as safety-related on plant documents and in information handling systems that are used to control plant activities that may affect these components.

PASNY responded to the requirements in submittals dated November 9, 1983, June 29, 1984, July 2, 1985, December 31, 1985, March 20, 1987, and October 16, 1989. The staff has evaluated those responses and finds them to be acceptable. Our Safety Evaluation and the Technical Evaluation Report by our contractor, EG&G Idaho, Inc., are enclosed for your information.

This completes Item 2.2.1 of Generic Letter 83-28 for the FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant and completes action on TAC No. 53672.
