
Dear Mr. Zurakowski:

The following actions have been taken to remedy the violations stated on Document No. 030-17576:

1. Records for performance tests have been compiled by the manufacturer and will be sent to the agency in September 1989. All records or tests will be handled this way in the future.
2. Warning labels have been ordered for the depth moisture probes and will be placed on the probes upon arrival.
3. Shipping paper are now being utilized for all transport of hazardous materials.
