SUBJECT: REVISED AGENDA FOR CRGR MEETING NO. 200

The Committee to Review Generic Requirements (CRGR) will meet in the morning on Tuesday, February 26, 1991, in Room 12-B11, OWFN. The agenda is as follows:

- 8:00-8:30 a.m. E. Rossi (NRR) will brief CRGR on recent operating experiences with standby liquid control systems in BWR's and the possible need for a bulletin.
- 8:30-9:30 a.m. J. Heltemes (RES) will discuss a proposed rule on selection, training and qualification of nuclear power plant personnel. This package was delivered to CRGR members on Friday, February 15. The CRGR staff expects to provide an issue sheet, if appropriate, by Friday, February 22. Due to the urgency of this matter with respect to judicial guidance, and considering that the backfit rule does not apply, it is hoped that the CRGR can complete its review.
- 9:30-11:00 a.m. E. Rossi (NRR) will present for CRGR review a line item technical specification improvement on changes in surveillance intervals. This package is No. 36, which was mailed to CRGR members on Friday, February 15. The CRGR staff expects to provide an issue sheet by Friday, February 22.
- 11:00-11:15 a.m. The CRGR will briefly discuss planning and agenda matters for future meetings. The CRGR staff will provide a status report by February 22, 1991.

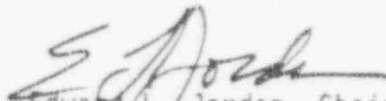
If a CRGR member cannot attend the meeting, it is the responsibility of his or her office to assure that an alternate, who is approved by the CRGR Chairman, attends the meeting.

Persons making presentations to the CRGR are responsible for (1) assuring that the information required for CRGR review is provided to the Committee (CRGR Chapter - IV.B), (2) coordinating and presenting views of other offices, (3) as appropriate, assuring that other offices are represented during the

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presentation, and (4) assuring that agenda modifications are coordinated with the CRGR contact (J. Conran x29855) and others involved with the presentation. Division Directors or higher management should attend meetings addressing agenda items under their purview.

In accordance with the EDO's March 29, 1984 memorandum to the Commission concerning "Forwarding of CRGR Documents to the Public Document Room (PDR)," the review packages for items scheduled at this meeting, which contain predecisional information, will not be released to the PDR until the NRC has considered (in a public forum) or decided the matter addressed by the information.
