NRC Names New Resident Inspector at Peach Bottom Nuclear Power Plant



Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in King of Prussia, Pa., have selected Peter Boguszewski as the NRC resident inspector at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station in Delta, Pa. He joins Senior Resident Inspector Justin Heinly at the two-unit plant, which is operated by Exelon Nuclear.

Boguszewski joined the NRC in the NRC Region I office in 2015 as part of the agency's Nuclear Safety Professional Development Program. After graduating from the two-year program and completing a rigorous inspector training program, he worked as a project engineer in the Division of Reactor Projects. He is a graduate of the University of Rochester, where he earned a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring major work projects and interacting with plant workers and the public.
