I have enclosed six copies of the draft detailed environmental statement for the Oconee Nuclear Station, the first we have issued under the revised Appendix D of 10 C/R Part 50.

We have followed the outline previously developed with two important exceptions. (1) one section (Section VI) is devoted to plant accidents and transportation accidents, and (2) the "Alternatives" and "Cost-Benefit Analysis" sections have been combined into a single section. It is possible that we may consolidate other short sections, e.g. the "Adverse Effects" and "Irreversible, etc."

Any comments or suggestions you wish to make on the Oconee statement, particularly with respect to its scope, organization, and emphasis, will be appreciated.

During the next two weeks, we expect to issue several more draft detailed statements. Your comments and suggestions on these will also be welcomed.
