DUKE POWER COMPANY (OCONEE 1) - SHIFT STAFFING

With regard to your memorandum of February 22, 1973, we have discussed the above subject with Duke Power Company. Duke stated that it intends to comply with the Unit 1 Technical Specifications 6.1.1.6 a., b. and c. as written. Duke informed us that the man holding the supervisor title who will be assigned as a licensed operator to Unit 1 will not be the Unit 1 supervisor but will serve primarily as relief for the other licensed operators assigned to Unit 1. Since it is anticipated by Duke that this man will have spare time from Unit 1 duties, he will be available to assist in Unit 2 preoperational activities. This arrangement is not inconsistent with the basis for the requirement for the relief licensed operator. Therefore, we find this arrangement to be acceptable.
