Gentlemen:

This refers to the investigation conducted on May 24-27, 1977, at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant Unit 1 by Messrs. C. C. Williams, F. J. Jablonski and J. E. Kohler, of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-80 and the discussions held at the conclusion of the inspection by Mr. Williams with yourself and other members of your staff on May 27, 1977.

A copy of our report of this investigation is enclosed and identifies areas examined during this investigation. Within these areas, the investigation consisted of interviews with an alleger, plant construction and management personnel, observations, examination and evaluation of plant as-built conditions, and examination of records.

This investigation focused on the alleged nonconforming construction activities relative to the blockout and penetration sealing activities performed by your site contractor, Brand Industrial Services Company. Further, this investigation included the impact of these allegations on the forthcoming testing of the emergency ventilation system relative to the configuration of the "negative pressure boundary." Four of the allegations were substantiated and resulted in the issuance of an immediate action letter on May 31, 1977.

During this investigation, certain of your activities were demonstrated to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as described in the enclosed Appendix A.
