SUMMARY OF ACRS SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING

As part of its review of the application of Toledo Edison Company, et al for a license to operate the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1, an ACRS Subcommittee (C. P. Seiss, M. W. Carbon, and J. C. Ebersole), held a public meeting on December 21, 1976 at 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

The meeting followed closely the planned agenda (enclosed). Formal transcripts are available which include copies of visual aids and handouts used during the meeting.
