We are enclosing herewith an amendment to your indemnity agreement reflecting the changes to 10 CFR Part 140, "Financial Protection Requirements and Indemnity Agreements," effective May 1, 1977. The amendments to Part 140, a copy of which is also enclosed, give effect to the increase from \$125 million to \$140 million in the primary layer of nuclear energy liability insurance provided by Nuclear Energy Liability-Property Insurance Association and Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters. Further, the amendments make certain other changes in the regulations necessitated by enactment of Public Law 94-197.

AMENDMENT NO. 2


Effective ~~MAY~~ MAY 1977, Indemnity Agreement No. B-79, between Toledo Edison Company and Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, dated June 16, 1976, is hereby amended as follows:

The amount "\$125,000,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$140,000,000" is substituted therefor.

The amount "\$96,875,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$108,500,000" is substituted therefor.

The amount "\$28,125,000" is deleted wherever it appears and the amount "\$31,500,000" is substituted therefor.
