Notice of Availability of Detailed Statement on Environmental Considerations

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and to the Atomic Energy Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Part 50, notice is hereby given that a document entitled "Detailed Statement on the Environmental Considerations by the Division of Reactor Licensing, U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, Related to the Proposed Construction of Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station by The Toledo Edison Company and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company" is being placed in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and in the Ida Rupp Public Library, Port Clinton, Ohio, where it will be available for public inspection. Appended to the statement are the applicants' environmental report and the comments of various Federal, State and local agencies. A public hearing on the application for a construction permit will be held in Port Clinton, Ohio, commencing December 8, 1970.
