The Toledo Edison Company and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company have filed an application for a construction permit and facility license to authorize construction and operation of a pressurized water nuclear reactor, designated as the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, on the applicants' site in Ottawa County, Ohio. The site is located on the southwest shore of Lake Erie, approximately twenty-one miles east of Toledo, Ohio.

We have examined the National Register of Historic Places and have not identified any registered historic landmarks within the immediate vicinity of the proposed plant.
