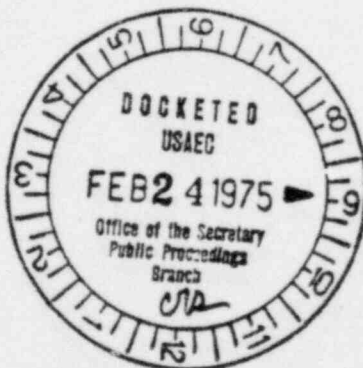
NOTICE OF RECONSTITUTION OF BOARD


Reconstitution of the Board in this manner is in accordance with Section 2.721 of the Rules of Practice, as amended.
